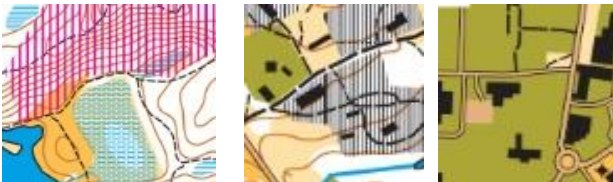

During the competition, traffic is not restricted, so participants are responsible for following traffic safety rules. There is 1 snack and drinking point located in the competition area, where drinking water, tea, vegetarian and traditional snacks (pies, bacon rolls, pickles and mushrooms, raisins, etc.) will be available.



Prohibited areas, i.e. areas that are prohibited from crossing, are marked on the map with a red line (micro-prohibitions) or a gray line (fenced or unfenced production areas). Prohibited areas, i.e. areas that are prohibited from crossing unless a road marked on the map passes through them, are marked in olive green.

Competition Center



The competition center is located indoors (in the School gym). It is **FORBIDDEN** to enter the competition center (premises) with studded and muddy shoes! It is allowed to enter the gym only barefoot, in socks or with shoe covers, clean gym shoes. The competition center will provide registration, reading and viewing of results, awarding, toilets, breakfast and post-finish catering, and storage of car keys. Both vegetarian and traditional cuisine are available for post-finish catering.

Tables and chairs will NOT be available for participants. We recommend that you bring your own. Please bring YOUR OWN spoons!

Team registration takes place at the Competition Center. Upon registration, participants receive a team envelope with a Freedom Rogaining souvenir for each participant, participant numbers, pin badges, assigned SIAC Air cards, SI card holders, and a bag for inserting keys.

10:30 a.m. We will begin gathering for the opening of the competition outside at the sports center.

11:00 a.m. After the opening of the competition – Issuance of maps – outside (in the competition opening area). Maps are received by one team representative when receiving a set of maps. The team must be registered for the competition, i.e. with a visible (attached) competition number. Map sets will be issued according to the number of team participants with one map attached for planning.

The team must read its result by the closing of the respective finish. Submission of a protest about the competition results - within 15 min. after the closing of the respective finish.

Before entering the start zone:

- 1) Clear your SI cards at the CLEAR station.
- 2) When entering the start zone, present your SI card attached to your wristband and check the start zone with the judge.

General Start after the signal at 12:00

The stations will be switched on in contactless mode with an operating zone of 30 cm (0.3 m). Attention to participants: It is possible that the first participant must “wake up” the forest station to activate the contactless system. All participants of one team must check in at the checkpoint within 1 (one) minute.

After each distance awarding - surprise prize draw. Only participants present will participate in the draws! C

Clothing with reflective elements and a headlamp is MANDATORY for each 6h distance participant. Clothing with reflective elements is desirable for 4h and 3h participants.
